Annual Meeting and ECTys Celebration

Attendance: 250+ When: March

Held in the first quarter each year, the Chamber membership is invited to elect the incoming leadership of the Chamber, review the past year with the debut of our Annual Report, and celebrate our signature "ECTy" Awards (named in the style of the Grammy or ESPY awards), presented to 10 companies and individuals for business growth, economic impact, community engagement, innovation, and collaboration. Following the meeting segment, the event generally features a cocktail hour and dinner, or a heavy hors d'oeuvres reception.

When: September

An impactful morning that brings the business and service community together, featuring the presentation of our Military Community Support Awards, remarks by senior service leaders from the US Navy, US Coast Guard, and US Army National Guard, and a patriotic performance by a local school choir. Attendance: 200+ When: November

A 'feel-good' holiday-time program that features the presentation of five 'Social Service Awards' to dedicated nonprofit leaders and volunteers and a keynote addressing topical issues for nonprofit management. Sponsors allow the Chamber to extend complimentary invitations to every member social service agency as a token of our community's appreciation.

Service Person of the Month

Attendance: Varies When: Monthly

Each month, the Chamber partners with a local service club (Rotary, Kiwanis, Lions) and a command from the US Naval Submarine Base, US Coast Guard, or US Army/National Guard to present an award to a service member, nominated by their Commanding Officer for outstanding military service and dedicated community engagement.

Leadership Eastern Connecticut

Cohort Size: 30-35

When: 10 sessions per year, September – June

For more than 38 years, Leadership Eastern Connecticut has prepared future business and community leaders for positions of responsibility by acquainting them with significant procedures and issues that affect our region. In this two-year development program, promising mid-career professionals explore behind-the-scenes across the region, meet with established leaders, forge lasting connections, and give back to the community with a capstone service project. Also includes Clifton Strengths Finder 2.0 Assessment.

Entrepreneur Academy

Cohort Size: 40

When: Fall

Participants will learn how to start a business in Connecticut or online through the Chamber's 8-week Entrepreneur Academy, designed to help emerging entrepreneurs turn their ideas into profitable ventures. Participants receive expert training, mentorship, and access to local resources, culminating in a public business pitch event. Ideal for big thinkers in the concept phase or early stage of business, the academy offers a comprehensive curriculum crafted by a professor of entrepreneurship at Wesleyan University. The Academy is a notably diverse and inclusive program, with upwards of 50% of participants from underrepresented or marginalized groups.

Sponsorships allow the Academy to be offered for free, with cash prizes for the Most Promising Ventures.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & ENTREPRENEURSHIP CONTINUED

Regional Innovation Center

Launched in late 2023, the Regional Innovation Center offers a full-service entrepreneurial ecosystem with coworking stations, private offices, administrative support, programming, meeting space, and more, designed to drive economic development in our urban center and beyond. Located in an Enterprise and Opportunity Zone in downtown New London, it is conveniently accessible by car, rail, ferry, or bus and features amenities such as a shared kitchen/cafe, printing & mail services, high-speed Wi-Fi, Zen Den, and outdoor courtyard. The Center is operated by the Chamber, whose office is located on site. It was founded in partnership with the Chamber Foundation, State of Connecticut, City of New London, and regional corporate donors.

When: March

Presented by the Chamber's Education Council at CT State Three Rivers, high school students from schools across the region learn soft skills and gain firsthand insight from diverse leaders in growing industries, including manufacturing, technology, finance, marketing, and more.

When: 6-8 programs per year

These topical forums feature key business and political leaders addressing issues impacting our region. Each event begins with a hot meal, networking time, and Chamber updates. Recent speakers and topics include: Governor Lamont, Congressman Courtney, Senator Blumenthal, Senator Murphy, Tourism, Offshore Wind, Human Resources, Diversity in Leadership, Tribal Update, AI & Emerging Technologies, Workforce Development. CHAMBER FOUNDATION EVENTS

The Chamber of Commerce of Eastern Connecticut Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization that supports and promotes education and economic development, especially for children and families, in the Chamber's service area. Governed by an all-volunteer Board of Directors, the Chamber's staff manages administrative and event services.

NOTE: The Chamber Foundation is a **distinct** entity from the Chamber of Commerce. Charitable contributions are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Annual Holiday Gala - December

Attendance: 350-450

The Holiday Gala, hosted by Mohegan Sun, is the Foundation 's premier event, bringing together caring community members for a memorable evening in support of our neighbors in need. Guests enjoy a champagne reception, dinner and dessert buffets, photo stations, and live music. The Foundation's signature live auction, one of the largest in the region, is emceed by WFSB's Roger Susanin and led by professional auctioneer Max Wolf. Every dollar makes a difference!

Annual Bowl-A-Thon – April

Attendance: 56 (14 Teams)

Supporters form teams of 4 and compete to be the best bowlers *and* the best fundraisers, with prizes awarded for both, including a YEAR of free bowling from our host, High Rollers Luxury Lanes and Lounge. Bowlers enjoy casual networking, door prizes, and refreshments during 2+ hours of bowling. Proceeds support the Foundation's scholarship fund, empowering local high school students to pursue higher education.
